Prior to partnering with Nexxus Capital in 1998, he held various management positions at Grupo Santander and previously at Grupo GBM, Interacciones (now Banorte) and Serfín (now Santander). Arturo held positions in international, business, commercial and investment banking. He has been a member of the board and committees in several institutions and investment companies, as well as in various companies in which Nexxus Capital funds were investors.

Arturo is currently Chairman of the Board of Nexxus Capital and its Funds in Mexico and Chairman of the Board of Nexxus Iberia, a fund that operates in Spain and Portugal.
