

MARCELO TOKMAN RAMOS

INDEPENDENT MEMBER

Mr. Tokman is a prominent Chilean economist. He was the first Minister of Energy in Chile and President of the National Energy Commission. Previously he was General Coordinator of Advisers of the Ministry of Finance and Head of Studies of the Budget Directorate.

Amongst his executive experience in the energy sector, his positions can be highlighted as General Manager of ENAP (National Petroleum Company in Chile) and as CEO of South America for the Danish company Vestas. He has also been director of companies in the energy, health, insurance and transport sectors, and various non-profit organizations in Chile and abroad.

He is currently President of Alto Maipo, Director of Guacolda, Zeus OL and Maver Laboratory; Advisor to Innova (CORFO) and the Chile-California Council, and Vice President of Business at Conosur Risk Management. He is also a consultant at Harvard University's CID.

As for his academic training, Mr. Tokman is an economist at the Pontifical Catholic University of Chile and has an M.A. and Ph.D. in Economics at the University of Berkeley, California.
