



AWARD OF THE ROSARITO DESALINATION PLANT CONTRACT TO COX DE MÉXICO, S.A.B. DE C.V.

Mexico City, August 17, 2026 – Cox de México, S.A.B. de C.V. (“Cox México” or the “Issuer”) (BIVA/BMV: COXA*), in compliance with the provisions of Article 50 of the General Provisions Applicable to Securities Issuers and Other Securities Market Participants, hereby informs the investing public in general that, on August 14, the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources, through the National Water Commission (“CONAGUA”), issued the ruling awarding Cox de México S.A.B. de C.V. (formerly Cox Energy, S.A.B. de C.V.), in joint participation with Cox Engineering & Services, S.L. (formerly Cox Water, S.L.), the public works contract for the execution of the project named “Construction of the Rosarito Desalination Plant and Pumping Station for the Supply of Drinking Water to Tijuana and Playas de Rosarito, Baja California” (the “Project”), which will help address water scarcity in the northwest of the country, benefiting 994,000 inhabitants in its first stage.

The award resulted from the International Open Invitation to At Least Three Persons procedure No. IO-16-B00-016B00985-I-148-2026, the call for which was published on July 7, 2026, in which the proposal submitted was found to be the most advantageous, in accordance with the points-and-percentages evaluation mechanism.

The scope comprises engineering, the supply of specialized equipment and the construction of the infrastructure, which will provide a water supply source that is complementary to and independent of the Colorado River, strengthening the availability of water resources for Baja California.

Execution of the Contract will take place in the coming days, subject to the prior delivery of the documentation required by the Authority.
